School Uniform

Dear Parents/Carers

It is the belief of the Governors and staff at Queensbridge that the wearing of a school uniform unites the school and the wider community and enhances the school's and the pupil's image. Pupils take pride in their appearance and are proud to wear the school logo in public settings. Our uniform is hard-wearing and easy to wash! All uniform is unisex.

Guidelines

- All pupils, including Nursery, will be expected to wear the school uniform;
- The school will loan a school sweatshirt to any pupil who is unable to provide his or her own when representing the school;
- The school will try to support families to obtain the school uniform in cases of hardship;
- Parents are expected to name their child's clothing. Please do this, we have a lot of jumpers floating around school and we can't be expected to know who they belong to without a name!
- Pupils are not allowed to wear jewellery, with the exception of a wrist watch. This will be removed during PE. This aligns with **ALL** local high schools such as Harper Green, St James', Little Lever, Kearsley Academy and Mount St Joseph's.
- The school cannot be held responsible for any item of jewellery;
- Hairstyles should be neat, tidy and tied back when necessary. Extreme hairstyles/colours are not permitted (this also includes over the top hair accessories);
- If children wear headscarves, they must be plain black and no longer than shoulder length
- Acrylic nails, or nails which are overly long, are not permitted – neither is nail polish.

The uniform

Our uniform is set out below and comprises of a white shirt/blouse or polo shirt, grey skirt, dress, shorts or trousers, burgundy school jumper, cardigan or fleece and white, grey or black socks or tights. Summer dresses/skorts are permitted on warmer days. Grey or black leggings may be worn under skirts or dresses if required.

Shoes or boots must be black and look like shoes! Trainers or high heels are not allowed. Children wearing trainers when they shouldn't be, will be given a pair of plain PE pumps to wear during the day inside the building. If children want to bring trainers or wellies to change into during playtime then they are welcome to do so, but these must be quick to change into and not need any assistance from an adult.



PE Kit

Children come into school in their PE kit on their PE day. Our PE kit consists of a white t-shirt and **plain** black shorts, jogging bottoms or skorts. Stripes, patterns or logos on the jogging bottoms or shorts are not allowed. Leggings or tights may be worn under the shorts. Children should wear PE pumps or trainers of any colour. The ones shown here are from Asda online, £2 for a pack of 2 t-shirts, £8 for a pack of 2 jogging bottoms and £4 for a pack of 2 pairs of shorts.
